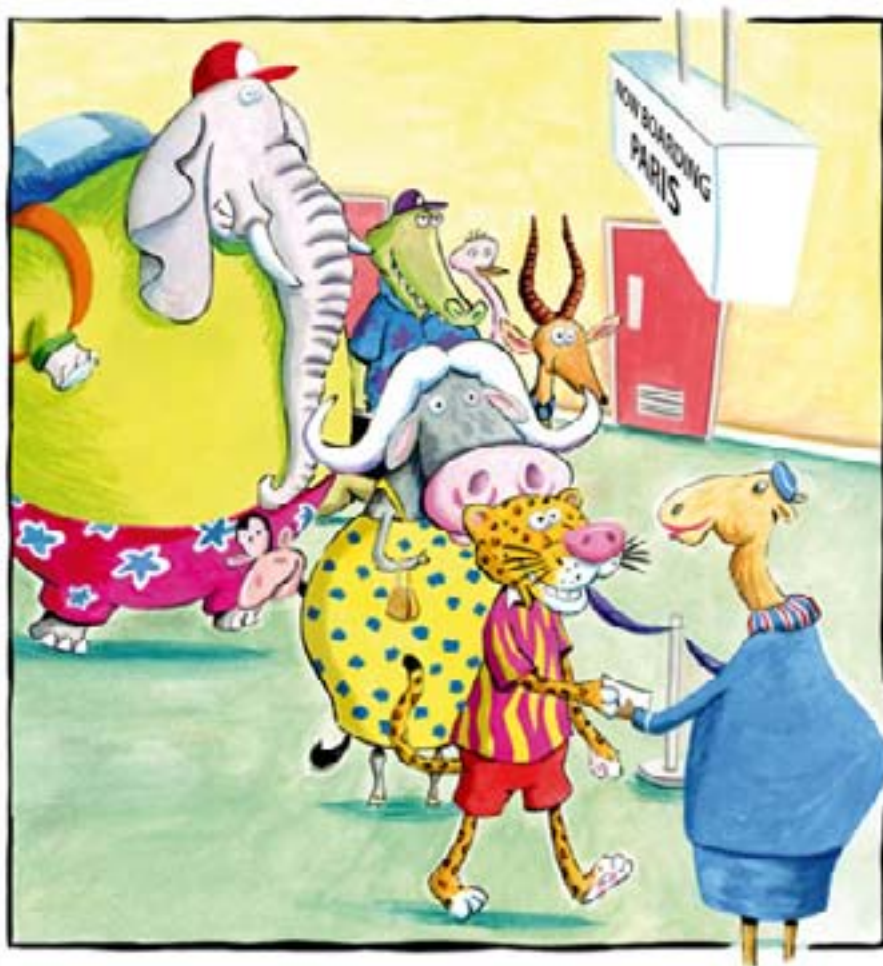


Then Leonardo showed his ticket and was free to board his flight. Leonardo smiled from ear to ear. He was on his way at last!

Leonardo looked at his map and hightailed it to the Louvre. It was about to close, but Leonardo got in by a whisker.

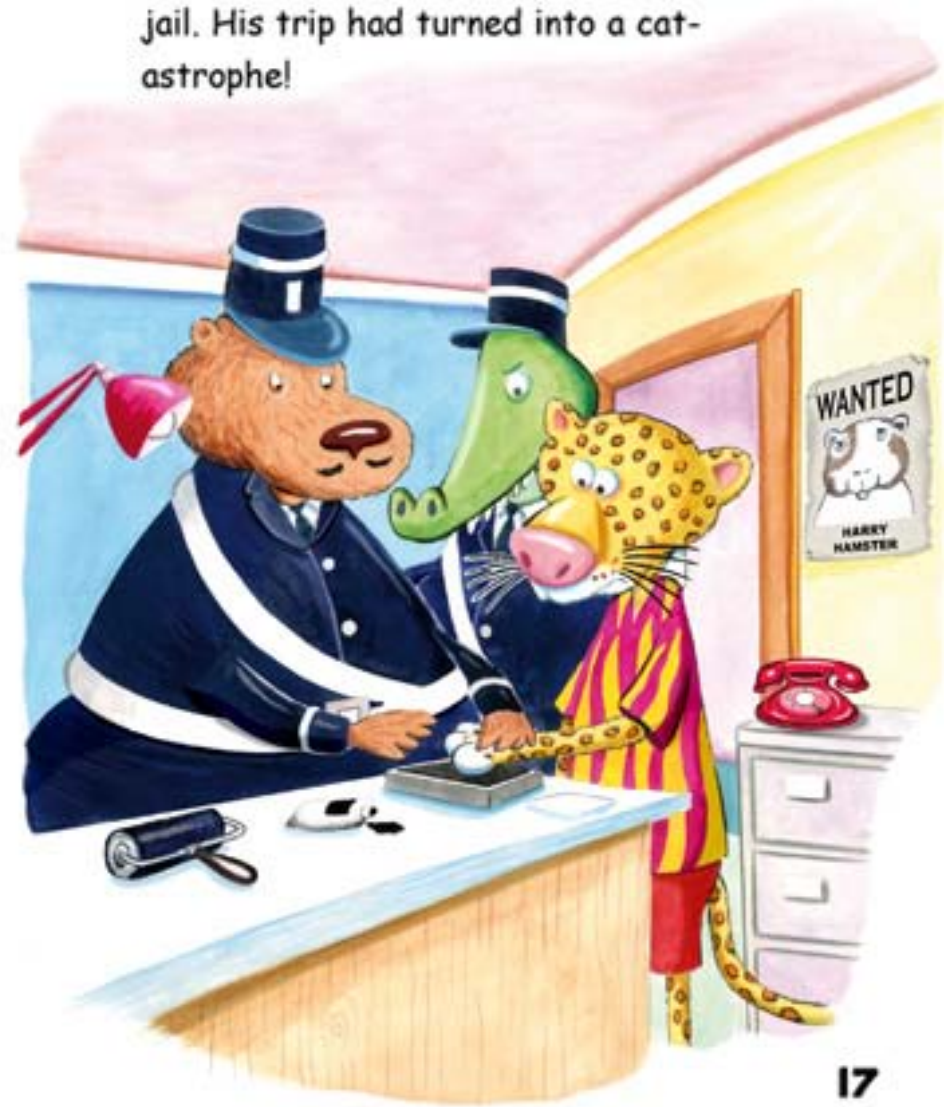


The Louvre was filled with famous paintings and sculptures. They shone in the spotlights. Leonardo gazed in wonder.
